Minutes of the meeting held in Putley Parish Hall

1. To receive apologies for absence:
Apologies were received and accepted from Councillor Daly.
2. To received declarations of Interest:

Councillor Lester reported on Cabinet and Full Council meetings. The Youth Criminal Justice System reports that the percentage of young offenders in the County is very low. Offsted report hat there are still improvements needed in children's safeguarding., more money has gone into Children's Services, Domestic Violence and Autism Support.
