## Minutes of the Parish Council meeting on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2021 At 7.30 in Putley Village Hall

Present: Councillors Stanier, Denman, Herbst and Booth. There was also a member of the public present.

1. To receive apologies for absence.

Apologies were received from Councillors Bodger, Taylor and Daly.

2. To record any Declarations of Interest and consider any Requests for dispensations. There were no Declarations of Interest received.

3. To receive a presentation regarding the possibility of creating a Peace Garden within the play area.

Following a resume from Councillor Denman of the background to the involvement in the Play Area by the Council, a resident from the housing association gave an interesting presentation for ideas for a Peace Garden and other uses for the play area.

4. To approve the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> May, 3<sup>rd</sup> June and 24<sup>th</sup> June 2021.

**RESOLUTION:** The minutes were approved.

5. Finance:

To consider payment of outstanding accounts:

- a. Clerks salary July & August.
- b. To approve the finance report and bank balances:

The current account stands at £8856.73 and the reserve account £11066.84.

**RESOLUTION:** Payment of accounts and reports were approved and bank account balances were noted.

6. Planning:

- a. To consider a response to planning application 211012, Proposed extension to provide additional seasonal workers accommodation by replacing existing agricultural building at Priors Grove, Putley HR8 2RE.

**RESOLUTION:** Putley Parish Council supports this application subject to the caveat that the Environment Agency and/or Buildings Regulation Authority conduct a site visit to investigate the current issues around foul water drainage from the existing property and the expected exacerbation of this issue with the proposed development.

We support the advice submitted by Welsh Water in their representation dated 01/07/21 and ask that the issue of foul water drainage and the risk of contamination to nearby water courses is properly investigated and addressed as part of this development.

- b. To consider a response in regard to potential for new build above Lazy Acre to affect private water supplies further down the hill.

The Clerk emailed the planning officer, however as the application had been approved and building work started the planning officer is unable to intervene.

The concern will be logged and taken into account if there are further applications.

- 7. To receive a report from the Footpath Officer.

Councillor Denman advised that groundworks at the Fosbury have resulted in the footpath being blocked but that it will be reopened shortly.

Balfour Beatty report that the budget is being cut again for rights of way,

- 8. To discuss the provision of Airband/Broadband for Putley Common.

Councillor Booth will draft a letter for the Clerk to send on.

- 9. To consider content for the Cider Press.

Councillor Booth will liaise with Councillor Taylor.

- 10. To receive agenda items for the next meeting.
